RESOLUTION EXPRESSING OUR FULL SUPPORT TO THE PASSAGE OF ANTI-TERRORISM ACT OF 2020 AND WE APPEAL TO OUR PRESIDENT RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE TO SIGN THIS BILL INTO A LAW.

WHEREAS, we believe that as young IP Leaders, we have the responsibility to speak and stood up for our IP Brethren who suffered the brutality of the Communist Terrorist. We want our tiny but unified voice be heard by our government;

WHEREAS, with all the efforts that we and our IP Leaders had exerted, we are gratified as the Congress passed **House Bill No. 6875 or the Anti-Terrorism Act of 2020**. This act is the solution to our quest for justice to all Indigenous Peoples who were victims of the atrocities of the Communist Terrorist;


WHEREAS, **Anti-Terrorism Bill** is our hope to end terrorism in our country; to spare the lives of the Indigenous children from becoming child warriors; and our hope to live in a peaceful and sustainable Ancestral Domains.

WHEREAS, this Act will protect the life of every Indigenous Peoples and defend our Ancestral Domains from exploitation of the communist terrorist;


